





[How to Continuously Ping on a MAC Computer!](#)

<p><b>Step 1:</b></p> <p>Open the Terminal App.</p>	
<p><b>Step 2:</b></p> <p>Type “ping 4.2.2.2” and press enter.</p>	
<p><b>Step 3:</b></p> <p>Allow the test to run before, during, and after a disconnection (or latency issue) occurs.</p>	
<p><b>Step 4.</b></p> <p>Press “Control” and “C” at the same time, to stop the test.</p>
